David Bergman is an architect in private practice. His firm works in a wide range of projects including houses and additions, apartment, loft and house renovations and commercial interiors. Conceptual research projects are also undertaken as time allows.

Fire & Water® is an offshoot company initially involved in the design and production of a series of copper candelabra, and since expanded to include six lines of light fixtures as well as custom and production furniture. The designs have been acclaimed by *The New York Times*, *Metropolis*, *Architectural Record* and other publications.

Prior to founding the office, David Bergman was a Project Architect at Redroof Design, managing both residential and commercial projects. Projects ranged from individual lofts and apartments to a major hotel renovation. He also worked with other New York offices including Kohn Pedersen Fox and Conklin Rossant. Bergman teaches at the Parsons School of Design. He is a past president and a board member of Furniture New York, an organization of New York designers, an executive board member of the Designers Lighting Forum of New York, and on the Municipal Art Society Urbanists steering committee. He is the co-editor of *Visual Seltzer*, an e-magazine which interviews New York designers, and wrote a monthly column, *By Design*, on residential design solutions for the website Edifice Rex (www.edificerex.com).

David Bergman received a Master in Architecture from Princeton University, and a Bachelor of Arts in Architecture and Economics from Yale University. He is a New York State Registered Architect and a LEED Accredited Professional®.
